Note: Living a holy life is a privilege. Peace, a clear conscience, praying powerfully, just as the Lord Jesus did, is how we were intended to live. Holiness is freedom.

'Lord, You set me apart because I am godly, You hear me when I call'

Psalm 4:3 Know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself; the LORD will hear when I call to him.

David's Decision, 'Lord I will set nothing wicked before my eyes'

Psalm 101:3 I will set nothing wicked before my eyes;

'Lord, I live right by reading and doing Your Word'

Psalm 119:9 How can a young man stay pure? By reading your Word and following its rules.

'Lord, I have hid Your Word in my heart so that I will not sin against You'

Ps 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.

'Lord, I will not let sin reign in my body and I do not obey its lusts'

Romans 6:12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

'Lord, I present myself to You, alive and as an instrument of righteousness'

Romans 6:13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

'Lord, My body is Your living sacrifice which is my reasonable service, please use me'

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

'Lord, I know that I am accountable to You for my actions so I purpose in my heart to live in a manner that pleases You'

Romans 14:12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

Lord, my body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, I will use it to glorify You

I Corinthians 6:19 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? **v20** For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

'Lord, I discipline my body and bring it in line so that I will never be a hypocrite'

I Corinthians 9:27 But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

Lord, out of reverence for You, I cleanse myself from all filth

2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

‘Lord, I am a Christian and have crucified improper passions and desires’

Galatians 5:24 And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

‘Lord, I have put off my former conduct which was corrupt’

Ephesians 4:22 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts,

‘Lord, I put to death any sin which may be in my life’

Colossians 3:5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

‘Lord, I put off what I should and I put on what I should’

Colossians 3:8 But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. **v9** Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds, **v10** and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him, **v12** Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; **v14** But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

‘Lord, You did not call me to live an unclean life, but to live holy

I Thessalonians 4:7 For God did not call us to uncleanness, but in holiness.

‘Lord, I abstain from every form of evil’

I Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from every form of evil.

Lord, godliness is profitable in all things

I Timothy 4:8 For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.

‘Lord, I flee from lust and pursue purity in my life’

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

‘Lord, I speak evil of no one, I walk in love’

Titus 3:2 to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men.

‘Lord, I follow peace and holiness with everyone therefore I am in fellowship with You’

Hebrews 12:14 Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

‘Lord, I am holy because You are holy’

I Peter 1:15 but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct,
